It's a Robbery!

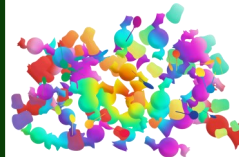
It's time to look at the evidence. We'll check the fingerprints and DNA evidence to see if we can solve this crime.
