



Piano Lessons *at* Montessori World School

*For students ages 7 years old and up
Academic year 2016-2017*

Tuesday and Thursday afternoons, *by appointment*

Elementary-aged children are offered the opportunity to learn to play the piano. Lessons will focus on increasing students' skill level in the areas of pitch and rhythm, and developing proper technique (use of fingers, hands, arms), while learning a repertoire of piano pieces that can be shared with family and friends. All students are invited to participate in two recitals during the year, presented at a local church.

Private piano lessons are **45 minutes** in length, one afternoon each week.

Partner lessons are **60 minutes** in length, one afternoon each week., and will pair 2 beginning students of similar age. This option is available when there are 2 compatible students interested in sharing a lesson time.

Piano lessons will take place after school on Tuesdays and Thursdays when Montessori World School is in session, **beginning August 30, 2016 and concluding May 25, 2017**. In addition, students will receive **five** weeks of lessons during the summer months.

Piano lessons at Montessori World are taught by Nancy Shackelford. Ms. Shackelford has a Master of Music degree, and is certified by American Montessori Society and Gordon Institute for Music Learning. She has been teaching piano since 1980.
